The arts scene is most definitely alive and well in Michigan City and there's no better way to experience it than by participating in one of the First Friday Art Walk. The Uptown Arts District to Millennium Park comes to life from 5-8pm as galleries and artisans from around the area showcase their work, including everything from painting, fused glass, architecture, culinary arts and even furniture making. Stroll the streets to the beat of live music that ranges from jazz to blues and more, as you visit gallery after gallery, shop after shop and thrill in the creativity and the best artistic talent the region has to offer.

If that is not enough, "Odyssey" is a sculpture exhibit located on the campus of Purdue University Northwest in Westville, IN. The 2016–2017 exhibits include 8 new pieces, bringing the total to 43 sculptures that grace the 269-acre Westville campus. This is a self-guided tour and brochures can be picked up in the main office.
